

HOW TO JOIN OUR CHURCH

1. Baptism--Any person may be received by baptism after giving satisfactory evidence of conversion.
2. Letter--Any person may be received on a letter of commendation from any church of like faith and order
3. Profession of Faith--Any person may be received who gives satisfactory evidence of conversion and subsequent baptism by immersion.
4. Watchcare--A member of any Christian church may be received under watchcare upon a personal request while retaining membership in another church. Persons coming under watchcare have all the privileges of the fellowship except voting and holding office.
5. **BY "WATCH-CARE"** - Students or other who are short-term residents of Springfield and do not wish to separate from their "home" church may become "watch-care" members by coming forward at the conclusion of the service.

Please feel free to call upon any of the Staff Pastors to receive additional information. You may call the church office at 417-862-0789 for an appointment with our ministry staff, e-mail us at uhbc@uhbc.org, or make a request on the friendship registration pad in the church pew.

During the "Hymn of Response," you may come to the front of the Worship Center and tell the Pastor of your desire to become part of the family of University Heights Baptist Church. Someone will assist you and pray with you about this important decision. You will then be presented to the church.
